

### 1. Out of bounds - Rule 27

#### 2. Internal out of bounds

#### 2.1. Internal out of bounds between holes 1 and 9

The out of bounds boundary between holes 1 and 9 starts at the path crossing both fairways and ends behind the teeing ground of hole 9. The out of bounds rule applies to hole 1 and 9.

#### 2.2. Internal out of bounds between holes 4 and 5/6

The out of bounds boundary between holes 4 and 5/6 starts behind the teeing ground of hole 4 and ends halfway through the fairway of hole 5. The out of bounds rule applies only to hole 4.

#### 2.3. Internal out of bounds for hole 12

### 3.Ground under repair. abnormal ground conditions - Rule 25

#### 3.1. Flowerbeds

All flowerbeds are considered around under repair. #### 4.3. Intergral parts of the course

All paths covered with bark mulch, as well as all bases of trees covered with bark mulch or earth/ground/soil, are considered integral parts of the course.

#### 5. Elevated power lines

If a ball strikes the elevated power lines on hole 9, the stroke is cancelled and the player must play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance with Rule 20-5.
